On behalf of the Organising Committee, I am delighted to invite you to participate in the **Session on Emerging Maritime Legal Questions** at the **3rd International Symposium on Naval Architecture and Maritime (INT-NAM 2018)**, which will be hosted by the Naval Architecture and Maritime Faculty of Yıldız Technical University in Istanbul, Turkey, from 23-25 April 2018. **INT-NAM 2018** is poised to be a major event in the area of ship and maritime technology research. It will provide an international forum for the exchange of cutting-edge information between academia, industry and regulatory bodies.

- . Polar Code
- . Hong Kong Convention, EU Ship Recycling Regulation
- . Technology Financing (liens, financial leasing, mortgages over ships, drilling vessels/platforms, offshore wind farms etc.)

The abstracts with paper title, author affiliation, keywords, and enough detail to reflect **advance knowledge in methodology or in the interpretation/application of existing knowledge** are kindly requested by **15 December 2017**. Authors will be notified by e-mail on their abstract acceptance or refusal immediately after the Scientific Committee reviews all submitted papers. The symposium e-proceedings will be published and distributed during the symposium.
